Bathroom #3 Scope

The tile floor and cove base will be removed. Drywall inside and around shower ceiling to be removed. Tile in shower to be removed along with shower tub surface. Transition going into shower will be removed and floor will need to be level with rest of the bathroom floor. Replace shower backer board if needed. Demo should be complete after previous tasks are completed. A section of subfloor will need to be replaced inside and outside of shower from previous leak. Update drain in shower and add trench drain along entry to shower. Raise plumbing for shower head in order to be a bit higher. Tile entire bathroom floor and shower floor with a slight pitch inside the shower transition area. Tile the cove base around room. Tile all shower walls. Rehang and install drywall in ceiling. Add grab bars in shower. Add a vent in shower that is tied into the light, so that the fan is always on when the light is on. Change toilet to be ADA. We will reuse vanity but the sink will need to be larger than its current size and the countertop will need to be replaced with a hard surface top. Change mirror. Reuse faucets. Paint room a new color.
